- Non-prescriptive ways implementation could be included in the report: successful methods and tools, enabling environments, benchmarking, mainstreaming, and case studies.
- Discussion of implementation should be highlighted where mitigation / transitions & adaptation / impacts are addressed in the report.
- Challenge to focus on the implementation, specifically in the context of 1.5
- Paint a picture of diversity – no one size fits all
- Plea to focus on positives and opportunities as well as challenges.
